Administrative detention is nowadays one of the most controversial mechanism of formal social control. It takes different forms and meanings and is present in many European and extra-European countries.

The Italian debate on administrative detention seems to be far from achieving definitive results, also because of the lack of transparency of the legal rules governing the administrative detention and information on detention centres applying it.

Moreover, administrative detention is a challenging issue for several subjects, from law to political science and administrative studies, from urban sociology, law and society, criminology and psychology, from anthropology to geography, from architecture to urban planning.

Experts from these and other thematic fields can improve the debate on this much disputed issue, which is the focus of the attention of several European and International human rights organizations.

This special issue of *Antigone* aims to collect papers on administrative detention from different points of view. Both theoretical and empirical contribution related to Italian, European and extra-European contexts are welcome. Papers will be accepted in Italian, English, French and Castilian Spanish and shall not exceed 60000 characters. Papers for publication are selected through peer review to ensure quality, significance and readability.
